Formative vs. Summative Zoo

Formative Assessment

To inform instruction and provide feedback to students on their learning; used throughout a given unit.

Summative Assessment

To measure and document the extent to which students have achieved a learning target; measured at the end of a given unit.

Formative Summative

Purpose	to improve instruction and provide student feedback	to measure student competency
Administered	ongoing and throughout unit	end of unit or course
Student Use Results	to self-monitor understanding	to gauge their progress toward course or grade- level goals and benchmarks
Teacher Use Results	to check for understanding	for grades, promotion

Wait Time

- Interval between the time a question is posed and the time either a student o teacher responds to the question
- Increased Wait Time can increase class participation, more detailed answers, complex thinking increases
- Wait Time 1 vs. Wait Time 2

No-Hands Questioning

- Great way to practice wait time
- Reinforces the notion that everyone's response is important
- Provide an opportunity for all students to be asked to share his or her ideas
